

St Ambrose's School Uniform Policy

FORMAL UNIFORM

- Check shirt or dress
- Bottle green culottes or shorts
- Bottle green wide brimmed hat with school logo
- Bottle green or white crew cut socks
- All black enclosed shoes (no canvas)

SPORTS UNIFORM

- Bottle green and gold sports shirt with school name on collar
- Bottle green culottes or shorts
- Bottle green wide brimmed hat with school logo
- Bottle green or white crew cut socks
- All black enclosed shoes (no canvas)
- On sports carnival days, team-coloured shirts and skins are permitted, along with trainers

ADDITIONAL WINTER UNIFORM OPTIONS

- Bottle green zip-up jacket with school logo
- Bottle green tracksuit pants (not to be worn under check dress, culottes or shorts)
- Bottle green tights (may be worn under the check dress, culottes or shorts)

ACCESSORIES

- Bottle green, white, gold or purple hair ribbons/scrunchies/head bands.
- Jewellery is limited to one set of plain sleepers/stud style earrings (one only per ear-both ears must be pierced), religious necklaces, medical bracelets and analogue/digital watches.
- Smart watches and wearable technologies with photographic abilities or internet connectivity can only be worn at school for safety reasons, must be disabled during school time and confirmed in writing to the Principal (click here).
- No make-up, nail varnish or polish is to be worn.

HAIR STYLING

- Students with shoulder length hair (touching the bottom of the collar) or longer, are to wear it tied back.
- Extreme hair styles are not permitted. These include but are not limited to: mohawks, rat tails, mullets, tracks, or anything shorter than blade 2.
- Natural hair colours only are permitted.

Students should wear their St Ambrose's School uniform in a neat and tidy manner. When wearing the uniform, children are representing the school. Please see further 'general expectations' listed below:

- Articles of clothing are to be marked clearly with the child's name.
- Full school uniform is to be worn every day.
- Children will arrive at school and depart from school in the correct uniform. If a child removes shoes etc. these must be replaced before leaving the school.
- Children wearing school uniform, outside of the school, must wear the uniform correctly.
- If your child/children are unable to fulfill the above expectations, a message should be forwarded to the class teacher.

The Principal has final discretion in all matters relating to the School Uniform Policy.
